Considered to be one of the best aero-engineering museums in the country, it houses amazing exhibits like a pilotless target aircraft (Lakshya), ejection seats with parachutes, ATC surveillance radars, etc.

Don't miss to see the sustainability park with working models of windmills, biogas plants, and solar-powered systems.

Enjoy a delicious meal at the open-air dining space after the museum tour (meal cost not included)

Bangalore Palace :visit the majestic Bangalore Palace, spread over an area of 45,000 acres! The architecture has influences from Indian, Scottish, and Gothic styles and features beautiful Roman arches, pillars, and vine-covered walls.

One should not miss to see the 35 rooms inside and their carved walls, fountains, stained glass windows, huge chandeliers, and paintings by artists like Raja Ravi Varma. One of the best attractions inside is the mother of pearl-studded dining table belonging to the Diwan of Mysore.

VidhanSoudha :This grand building, a very popular tourist attraction, is referred to as the 'TajMahal of South India' for its grandeur and pristine white architecture. This is the largest legislative building in India.

The design of the building has Dravidian, Rajasthani, South Indian, and Indo-Saracen influences and has beautifully carved granite pillars, walls, and domes. While antiques and rare paintings adorn the inside of VidhanaSoudha, the exteriors are dotted with lush gardens, fountains, and flowers.

Today morning after breakfast, check out start little early to proceed to Mysore, Enroute visit Lal bagh (if time permits) : 17th century Botanical garden, An initiative of the ruler Tipu Sultan, this garden has amazing attractions and is dotted with beautiful flower beds and ponds. It houses a 3,000-million-year-old rock, amongst the oldest in the world. The garden has over 1,000 exotic plants belonging to Afghanistan and Persia.

Spot birds like Brahminy kite, pond heron, and mynas here. Attend the famous flower shows or boat on the lake. See folk dances and music concerts organized every second & fourth weekend here.

Timings: 6:00 am to 7:00 pm all days

Entry fee : INR 20 per person

Tipu Sultan's Summer palace:Tipu Sultan's Summer Palace, also known as DariyaDaulatBagh, meaning "wealth of the sea" has been captivating visitors since long. This palace, which used to be the summer retreat of Tipu Sultan, was often called as the 'Abode of Happiness' and 'Envy of Heaven' by the constructor himself. Built on a raised stone platform, with pillars of teak and artistic interiors, this palace is one of the most interesting places to see on a Mysore tour.It was Hyder Ali Khan who started constructing this palace in the year of 1778. However, the construction was completed by his son Tipu Sultan in the year of 1784 AD.

Timings : 10:00 am - 6:00 pm on all the weekdays, on Sundays 08:30 am - 5:30 pm

Entry fees : INR 15 per person for Indian Nationals, INR 200 for Foreign Nationals. Check into to the hotel. Freshen up and by 5.00 pm drive to Brindavan gardens to enjoy the sound and light show.

Brindavan Gardens : Brindavan Gardens of Mysore is undeniably one of the best terrace gardens in the world. It is located about 12km towards the north west of the Mysore city. Brindavan gardens with its illuminated fountains, botanical park, extensive varieties of plants. It was the idea of Sir Mirza Ismail, the then diwan of Mysore state to beautify the area around the Krishnaraja Sagar Dam (KRS Dam) which is located in situated in Srirangapatnataluk of Mandya district. This dam, named after KrishnarajaWodeyar IV, has been built over Cauvery River, which is one of the prominent rivers of South India. Brindavan Gardens have been designed by seeking inspiration from Shalimar Gardens of Kashmir, which have been created in the ancient Mughal style. Hence, it also radiates grandeur and beauty, comprising of a wide array of fountains, terraces, water channels, parterres, lawns and flowerbeds, etc.

Today morning after breakfast start early and visit Mysore palace and later drive to Coorg. Mysore Palace :The present building of Mysore Palace was completed in 1912. Mysore Palace mesmerizes everyone with its magnificent architecture. Known as Indo-Saracenic, a beautiful blend of Hindu, Islamic, Rajput, and Gothic architectural style which the palace represents has been alluring watchers since time immemorial. Surrounded with an aesthetically designed vast garden, the palace is three storied building, built with stone and marble domes. It also has five-storied tower with a height of 145 feet. The most striking feature of the palace, its deep pink marble domes on top of grey granite three stories building, was designed by Henry Irwin. Its portico is designed with seven vast arches while the central arch is bordered by two smaller arches, surrounded by tall beautiful pillars.

Timings :10:00 am - 5:30 pm

Sound & light show Timings :

07.00 pm - 07.40 pm on weekdays (Monday to Saturday) except Sundays, National Holidays and State Festivals.

Illumination Timings :

07.00 pm - 07.45 pm on Sundays, National Holidays and State Festivals.

07.40 pm - 07.45 pm on Weekdays (Monday to Saturday) after the sound and light show.

Another attractive feature of the Mysore Maharaja Palace is the list of the special events that are organized here. The world famous and Mysore Dussera Festival is held at the Mysore Palace. During this extravagant festival of Mysore Dasara, stages are being set up in the palace ground where many famous artists perform. One the 10th day, when the festival of Dashami is celebrated, a parade with is highly ornamented elephants is conducted from the palace grounds. The festive fervor during this time at the palace and in Mysore is something that every traveler must experience at least once. It mostly occurs during the month of November or October.

During this festival, the Palace is lit with more than 96,000 lights for two months, which add an incomparable charm to the grand palace of Mysore.

Later drive to Coorg.

CoorgKodagu is an administrative district in Karnataka, India. Before 1956 it was an administratively separate Coorg State, at which point it was merged into an enlarged Mysore State. Coorg is known for its coffee and its people.

Best Time To Travel

Best time to visit South India is between Oct to March, though all the places have their own specific season.

North and South Kerala can also be visited during monsoons.

May - October : Ayurveda has played an important role in boosting tourism in the region. It's considered to be most effective in the monsoons, which extends from May to October. In October/November, most South Indian states also celebrate Dussehra and Diwali which is considered to be the peak season.

Rains is possible in different months at different places, keep a check on weather chart. <https://www.accuweather.com/>

If travelling during the winter season than pls carry light woolens for places like Munnar, Coorg, Chikmaglaur, Ooty, Kodai, Wayanand which are on hills.

Advised to carry mosquito repellent in all seasons as lot of areas are covered under forest areas, greenery.

Karnataka, Tamil nadu and Kerala has many waterfalls, monsoon is one of the season to enjoy the same.

Language Barrier

Kerala has highest literacy ratio and majorily speaks and understands English and Hindi.

Karnataka also understands English and Hindi.

Tamil Nadu has a language problem of hindi and English, majority of the people speaks Tamil and Malayalam. Guide is advisable here.

Drivers will speak English in Kerala but other parts of South india the driver speaks hindi and in Chennai and Tamil nadu the driver majority speaks tamil. They don't even understand or speak hindi/English.

Prohibition

All kinds of drugs and narcotic substances, activities such as smuggling and prostitution are illegal in Karnataka and will attract prosecution. Trespassing restricted areas, operating drones without permission and violation of any local rules and restriction should be avoided at all times.

Smoking is prohibited in public areas. Few facilities like airports may provide designated areas for smoking.

Nudity is not permitted in any beaches, waterfalls, pools or other public/tourist areas. PDA is discouraged.

Site seeing prices to be paid at entrance by self.

Optional activities to be booked and paid directly. Eg. Safari in national park, rafting, boat ride.

Safari to be booked priorily online.

Safaris can be booked online at national parks like Nagarhole national park in Kabini, Madumalai national park in Tamil nadu, Bandipur national park near Ooty.

Boat ride at Periyar Lake in Thekkady, Visit to Eravikulam national park in Munnar

Food

The Meals are generally in coconut oil, so you may find that unappealing.

Non Veg. & Veg. items are often on buffet table so please look for the Green dot or ask before picking doubtful things from menu.

Majority dishes are south indian items like idli, dosa, appam, sambhar, chutney, lemon rice, Chettinad Cuisine, fish curry and sea food.

Vegetarian food outlets outside the hotel can be few and limited so if you are not in group please plan your meals in advance.

Avoid drinking tap water, which has not been boiled, or ice cubes in drinks at all times, as most water sources in South India are untreated. One can easily get treated / boiled water at hotels. While on travel, advisable to use bottled drinking water.

The people of this area are mostly Non Vegetarian. Most of the hotels, serves both Vegetarian & Non-Vegetarian food.

The Jain food served by the hotels will be basic & cannot be compared, to the ones available, at the hometown of the traveler.

Dressing

Decent Dressing covering the full body (sleeveless & shorts to be avoided) required while visiting temples or worship places. South India has many temple sights, so it's advisable to carry at least one set of ethnic clothes.

Hospitality & Services

People are generally good clean & service oriented. Hospitality is at its best in Kerala compared to Karnataka and Tamil Nadu.

The places have all types of accommodations from guest house, home stay to high end luxury hotels. While staying in houseboats in Kerala, very basic food and limited cutlery and things gets available. It has a problem of bad smell of water, mosquito and insects. We recommend to take luxury houseboats which are fully covered with glass windows with 20 hrs AC.

Sea sickness is very common on these trips as majority of the places are near coastal areas in south. Hotels have their in-house policy of providing heater on complimentary / chargeable basis. For hotels used in budget, hotels provide room heater on extra payment. This amount needs to be settled, directly by the guest, with the hotels, before check-out.


